WY Rules and Reg. 040.0001.2 § 2

For the purpose of all hunting and trapping regulations, definitions shall be as set forth in Title 23, Wyoming Statutes, Commission regulations and the Commission also adopts the following definitions:

(a) "Accompanied by a Mentor" means being directly supervised at all times by

a mentor who is within sight and direct voice contact.

(b) "Adult" means a person eighteen (18) years of age or older.

(c) "Aircraft" means any machine or device (including but not limited to airplane,

helicopter, glider, dirigible or unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV)) capable of atmospheric flight.
