Cal. Civ. Code § 671

Current through laws passed by the Regular Session of the 2021 California State Legislature. Some statute sections may be more current.

§ 20. Noncitizens; property rights

Noncitizens have the same property rights as citizens.

§ 671. Persons authorized to own property

Any person, regardless of their citizenship status, may take, hold, and dispose of property, real or personal, within this state.
