5-27-4. Transfer of funds to ethanol fuel fund

During fiscal year 1999, the Bureau of Finance and Management shall transfer each month twenty-four and two-tenths percent of the monthly state capital construction fund revenues from the state capital construction fund to the ethanol fuel fund. Beginning in fiscal year 2000 to December 31, 2002, inclusive, the Bureau of Finance and Management shall transfer each month thirty-three and one-quarter percent of the monthly state capital construction fund revenues from the state capital construction fund to the ethanol fuel fund. Beginning on January 1, 2003, the Bureau of Finance and Management shall transfer each month twenty-five and six-tenths percent of the monthly state capital construction fund revenues from the state capital construction fund to the ethanol fuel fund.
