120/22. Flexible fuel vehicle database

§ 22. Flexible fuel vehicle database. The Secretary of State shall, to the extent that the necessary information is obtainable from automobile manufacturers, compile a database of the flexible fuel vehicles in the State by zip code area. The database shall be created based upon the make, model, and vehicle identification number of registered vehicles. The database shall include only the number of vehicles by zip code and shall be completed and made available to the public in both print and electronic format by January 1, 2005. For the purposes of this Section, “flexible fuel vehicle” means a vehicle that is capable of running on E85 blend fuel.
