120/32. Clean Fuel Education Program

§ 32. Clean Fuel Education Program. Subject to appropriation, the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, in cooperation with the Agency and Chicago Area Clean Cities, shall administer the Clean Fuel Education Program, the purpose of which is to educate fleet administrators and Illinois' citizens about the benefits of using alternate fuels. The program shall include a media campaign.
