On June 3, 2013, I issued a Decision and Order in which I found that Bodie S. Knapp committed 235 violations of the Animal Welfare Act, as amended (7 U.S.C. §§ 2131-2159) [Animal Welfare Act], and the regulations issued under the Animal Welfare Act (9 C.F.R. §§ 1.1-3.142) [Regulations].¹ Mr. Knapp sought judicial review of my June 3, 2013, Decision and Order, and on September 22, 2015, the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit remanded the proceeding to me to further address 68 of 235 violations of the Animal Welfare Act and the Regulations which I found Mr. Knapp committed.²

On October 20, 2015, I conducted a conference call with Phillip Westergren, counsel for Mr. Knapp, and Colleen A. Carroll, counsel for the Administrator, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, United States Department of Agriculture [Administrator], to discuss the manner in which to proceed on remand.³ Each party requested the opportunity to file a brief on remand and the parties agreed to the following briefing schedule.

The Administrator's brief on remand must be filed with the Hearing Clerk no later than December 1, 2015, and Mr. Knapp's response to the Administrator's brief on remand must be filed with the Hearing Clerk no later than January 20, 2016.⁴
