	)	<b>Order Granting Respondents'</b>
Respondents	)	<b>Motion to Modify Order</b>

In *In re Barnesville Livestock, LLC*, \_\_ Agric. Dec. \_\_\_ (Jan. 23, 2012), I suspended Barnesville Livestock, LLC [hereinafter Barnesville], as a registrant under the Packers and Stockyards Act, 1921, as amended and supplemented (7 U.S.C. §§ 181-229b) [hereinafter the Packers and Stockyards Act], for a period of 21 days. The suspension was to become effective on the 60th day after service of the Decision and Order on Barnesville and Darryl Watson. On February 29, 2012, Barnesville and Mr. Watson filed a motion requesting that Barnesville’s suspension as a registrant under the Packers and Stockyards Act “become effective immediately with a one week notice to Respondents instead of within sixty (60) days of the date from the date of service.”<sup>1</sup> On March 1, 2012, Alan R. Christian, Deputy Administrator, Packers and Stockyards Program, Grain Inspection, Packers and Stockyards Administration, United States Department of

Agriculture [hereinafter the Deputy Administrator], filed a response to Barnesville and Mr. Watson's motion stating the Deputy Administrator does not oppose Barnesville and Mr. Watson's requested modification of the January 23, 2012, Order. On March 1, 2012, the Hearing Clerk transmitted the record to the Office of the Judicial Officer for a ruling on Barnesville and Mr. Watson's motion to modify the January 23, 2012, Order.

Based upon the agreement of the parties, I vacate paragraph 2 of the Order in *In re Barnesville Livestock, LLC*, \_\_ Agric. Dec. \_\_\_\_ (Jan. 23, 2012), and substitute the following in its place:

2. Barnesville is suspended as a registrant under the Packers and Stockyards Act for a period of 21 days. Barnesville's suspension as a registrant under the Packers and Stockyards Act shall become effective on the 7th day after service of this Order Granting Respondents' Motion to Modify Order on Barnesville and Mr. Watson.
