### States' Farm Animal Welfare Statutes: Indiana

Effective January 1, 2011

The statutes and Constitution are current with all legislation of the 2022 Second Regular Session of the 122nd General Assembly effective through June 30, 2022.

#### Ind. Code § 15-17-3-23

The board may adopt rules to establish standards governing the care of livestock and poultry.

The board shall consider the following when adopting the standards:

- (1) The health and husbandry of the livestock and poultry.
- (2) Generally accepted farm management practices.
- (3) Generally accepted veterinary standards and practices.
- (4) The economic impact the standards may have on:
  - (A) livestock and poultry farmers;
  - (B) the affected livestock and poultry sector; and
  - (C) consumers.
