Crisis Services of North Alabama: The mission of Crisis Services of North Alabama is to respond to individuals and families in crisis. This crisis line is operated from Huntsville, Alabama, but calls are toll-free in Alabama and Tennessee. The Crisis Center (Central Alabama): The Crisis Center, although not specific to agriculture, primarily serves Central Alabama, which is defined as the five-county area surrounding Birmingham. This includes Blount County, Jefferson County, St. Clair County, Shelby County and Walker County. Their mission is "to serve to serve the unmet needs of people experiencing personal crisis or mental health issues and respond with services that promote coping, emotional health and well-being."
