Mental Health Resources & Hotlines: California

Crisis Support Services of Alameda County: This service offers support to people of all ages and backgrounds and operates on a volunteer basis. The 24-hour crisis lines offers confidentiality, teletype (TDD) services for deaf and hearing-impaired callers, and translation in 140 languages. Second Chance, Inc. Hotline: This hotline most commonly serves the Fremont, Newark, Union City and Eden areas in southern Alameda County. The line is available from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. on weekdays, and they offer call-back hours on weekends and 10:00 p.m. – 8:00 a.m. Monday – Friday.
